- 3.0 Review our School Budget- Swann Total budget for 2022-2023 SY is \$4,708,922, \$6,364,551 is the total including all pots of money (Title I, GATE, etc.)
- 4.0 Title 1 Plan-Swann Allocation: \$143,640 which pays for J. Mohr, three CTTS, and books and supplies
- 5.0 School Performance Plan (SPP)-Swann Schoolwide goals: Decrease the percentage of students scoring at or below the 40%tile in Math from 49% (fall) to 48% (winter) to 45% (spring) by 2022 as measured by the MAP Growth Assessment. Decrease the percentage of students scoring at or below the 40%tile in ELA from 41% (fall) to 38% (winter) to 35% (spring) by 2022 as measured by the MAP Growth Assessment. Decrease the percentage of students scoring at or below the 40%tile in Science from 44% (fall) to 47% (winter) to 41% (spring) by 2022 as measured by the MAP Growth Assessments.
- 6.0 School Wide Data WIDA, MAP & i-Ready- Tenisha Brunetti and Angela Reinhard Reviewed Math MAP data for grades K-, Reading MAP scores K-5 were reviewed, and SCIENCE grades 3-5. iReady Reading red section is shrinking and 37% of the students are yellow (bubble). iReady Math red section is shrinking and 51% of the students are yellow (bubble).
