School staff have noticed and are working on this through social-emotional lessons and conversations. We encourage students to report issues as soon as they happen so that we can get to the bottom of it quickly.

9.0 STAR RATING in REVIEW!- Mrs. Swann shared the Star Rating report and discussed the importance of reducing chronic absenteeism.
